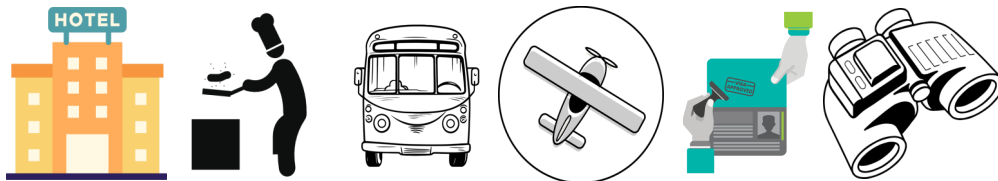

Day 1—Arrival London — River Thames cruise

Dinner

Welcome to London! After your Immigration and Custom Formalities you will be transferred to the hotel and check in to the hotel. (Please note that Standard Check in time is 1600 Hrs). London is considered to be one of the world's most important global city and has been termed the world's powerful, desirable, influential & most visited city of United Kingdom. London has a diverse range of people and cultures, and more than 300 languages are spoken in the region. In evening enjoy the dinner on River Thames Cruise. Admire beautiful London landmarks and savour delicious dishes, as a luxury boat takes you on an unforgettable experience along the river. Overnight stay at London Hotel.

Day 2—London Hop on Hop Off Tour – Visit London Eye—Visit Madame Taussaud's Wax Museum

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After Breakfast Manage Transfer On Your Own Towards Hop-On Hop-Off Station. Get Acquainted with Some of London's Iconic Landmarks Like The Tower Bridge, River Thames, London Eye, Tower Of London, Hyde Park, Big Ben, Westminster Palace, Westminster Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, The Famous Piccadilly Circus, And Nelson's Column At Trafalgar Square Followed By The Majesty Of Buckingham Palace Which Is The Queen's Official Residence. Enjoy The Changing Of The Guard (Subject To Operation). Later Visit Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum, the World's Largest Exhibition Of Life Like Wax Models Of More Than 400 Celebrities, Also Get Chance To Take Photograph With Some Indian Celebrities. Then Proceed To 'London Eye', At 135 Meters It Is The Tallest Observation Wheel In Great Britain. Its Fully Enclosed Capsules Offer Stunning Views To The Edge Of The Capital And Beyond. It Is An Unforgettable Experience! Overnight Stay At London Hotel.

Day 3— London—Windsor Castle—Visit Stonehenge

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast proceed to city centre on your own to visit Windsor Castle & State Apartments, which is said to be the weekend home of the Royal family (subject to operation). You'll see the gorgeous State Apartments- created by George IV in the 1820s. The Castle is a world heritage site. Later Proceed to Stonehenge, Situated on Salisbury Plain in the Wiltshire countryside, the cluster of 40-ton rocks were constructed more than 5,000 years ago. Although the function of Stonehenge is still a matter of fierce debate, what is known about the UNESCO World Heritage Site is that it has been a site of pagan worship for centuries. Overnight stay at London hotel. .

Day 4— London—Glasgow

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast check out from the hotel and proceed to London train station on your own for Glasgow. Arrive Glasgow & transfer to your hotel on your own and check in to the hotel. Glasgow is a port city on the River Clyde. It's famous for its Victorian-and art nouveau architecture, a rich legacy of the city's 18th–20th-century prosperity due to trade and shipbuilding. Today it's a national cultural hub, home to institutions including the Scottish Opera, Scottish Ballet and National Theatre of Scotland, as well as acclaimed museums and a thriving music scene. Overnight stay at Glasgow hotel.

Day 5—Glasgow—Hop on Hop Off

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast manage transfer on your own towards Hop-on Hop-off station in which you can visit some amazing places of Glasgow. Explore the rich cultural heritage of the city through its museums and wonder at amazing paintings in the art galleries. Stroll through the picturesque parks and marvel at the flora in the botanical gardens. Glasgow Cathedral also called the High Kirk of Glasgow or St Kentigern's or St Mungo's Cathedral, is the oldest cathedral on mainland Scotland and is the oldest building in Glasgow. Since the Reformation the cathedral continues in public ownership, within the responsibility of Historic Environment Scotland. Overnight stay at Glasgow hotel.

Day 6—Glasgow—Loch Lomond & Clydeside Distillery Whiskey Tour

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast travel the short distance towards Loch Lomond, one of the largest lochs in Scotland. Stop on the southern shore of the loch, where you can choose to join a 1-hour boat cruise and enjoy views of the surrounding mountains and castles. Those who wish to remain on dry land can admire the stunning landscape from the shore. The next stop is in the picturesque conservation village of Luss. Walk around the center and take photos of quaint cottages, or stroll along a little beach on the bank of Loch Lomond and admire the view of Ben Lomond. After a day filled with mountain air, lochs, and forests, travel back to Glasgow's Clydeside Whisky Distillery. Located in the famous Queen's Dock, this state-of-the-art distillery brings the production of single malt back to the city. Take a tour and see how this whiskey is distilled from grain to glass. Overnight stay at Glasgow hotel.

Day 7 Glasgow—Edinburgh

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast check out from hotel and Proceed Inverness train station on your own for Edinburgh. Arrive Edinburgh & transfer to your hotel on your own and check in to the hotel. Edinburgh is one of Scotland's much loved cities and is home to world-renowned summer festivals, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, as well as bags of history to uncover. Explore historic monuments, lovely green spaces, top-class dining experiences, fantastic shopping locations and much more in all the nooks and crannies across the city. Overnight stay at Edinburgh hotel.

Day 8—Edinburgh –Hop On Hop Off

Breakfast,Lunch,Dinner

After breakfast manage transfer at your own towards Hop-on Hop-off station in which you can visit some amazing places of Edinburgh. The tour has an exceptional array of stops - all strategically located to get you up close with your favourite attractions, from the spectacular Edinburgh Castle to the 15th-century John Knox House. Edinburgh Castle has stronghold that was once the residence of Scottish monarchs and now serves mostly as a museum. It stands 443 feet (135 metres) above sea level and overlooks the city of Edinburgh from a volcanic crag called Castle Rock. Castle Rock has been the site of human activity for at least 3,000 years. See The Palace of Holyrood house has been home to royalty for over 500 years, and is still the official residence of The Queen in Scotland. Overnight stay at Edinburgh hotel.

Day 9— Edinburgh – Hometown

After breakfast proceed to Airport on own to board flight from Edinburgh.
